

*History Loans boxes are subject to an additional £8 per box VAT rate for academy schools. Loans are for two weeks unless a longer term is required at an additional charger per week. Organise an initial consultation and planning discussion with us.

NB// The costs below are based on working with whole year groups. For example, if you choose silver and want a visit to the Art Gallery you will be entitled to a whole year group doing this twice within the SLA year, e.g., Yr3 and Yr5 could visit on separate occasions.

NB// non-Southampton Schools will occur a charge of .45p per mile for on-school-site teaching visits. Schools over one hours travel time will also occur a travel charge per visit.





Interactive assemblies

We realise how quickly things are changing at the moment and that booking a trip may feel like a risk to you and your parents.


However, we can still bring art and history to your students via Zoom or the platform of your choice, providing fun, interactive and activity packed sessions.


