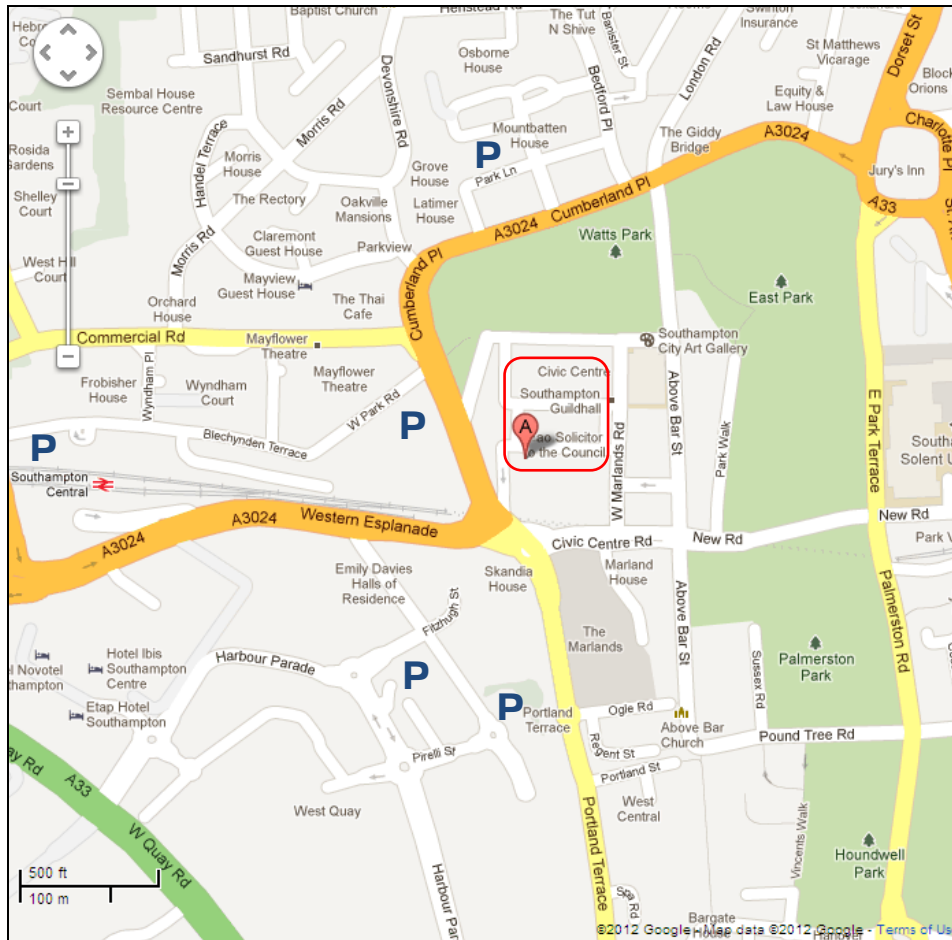


How to get to the ICT Strategy Training Room Civic Centre, Southampton SO14 7LY

Our ICT Training Room is based on the ground floor of the Civic Centre (room 101) close to the main reception desk at the front of the building (see plan overleaf).

Car Parking

There is disabled parking and limited short-stay parking (2 hours max.) available at the front and rear of the building.

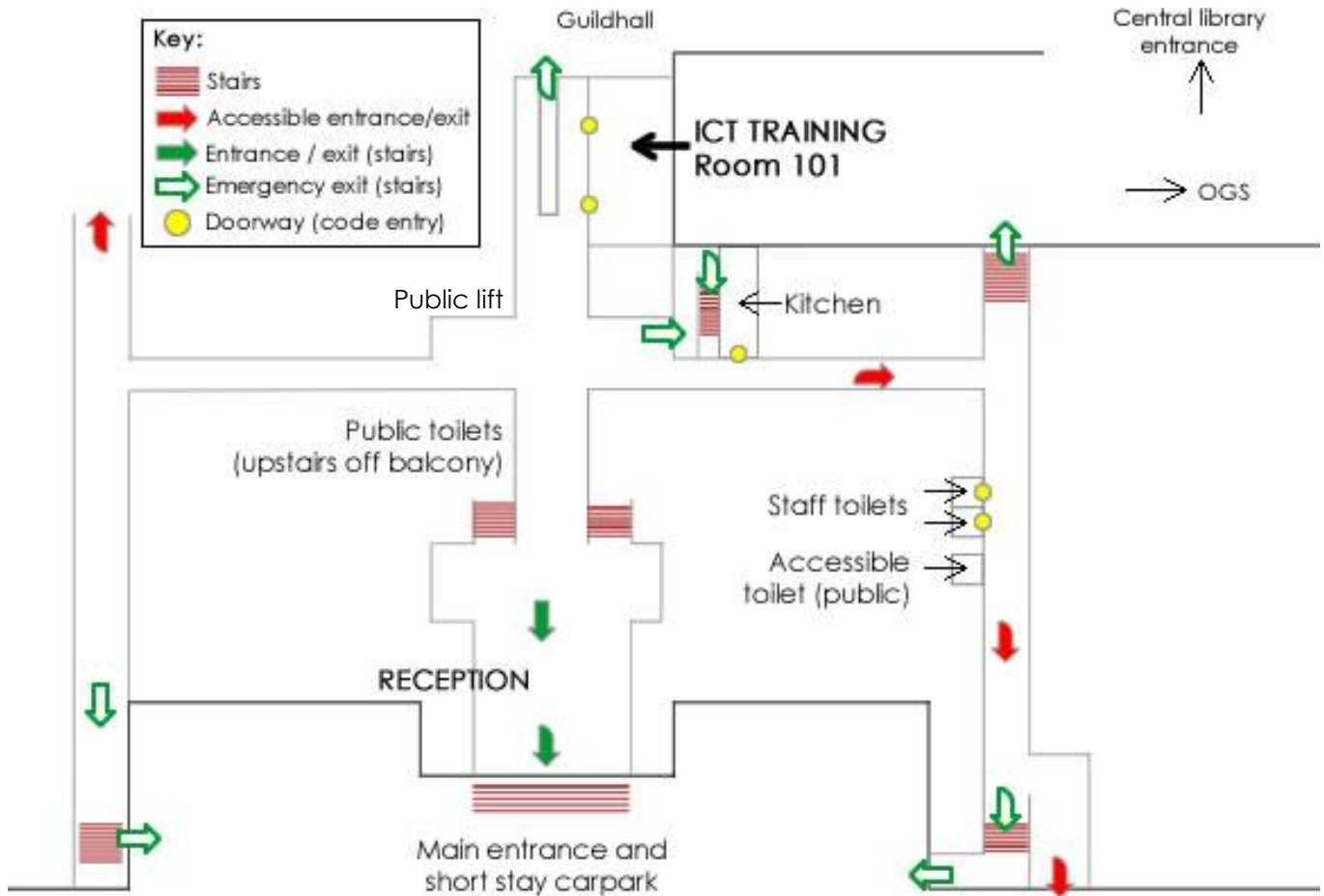
Bus Services

Train Services

Southampton Central Train Station is a 5 minute walk from the Civic Centre. Check www.nationalrail.co.uk for latest information on trains and timetables.

On arrival you may proceed to the room (if the trainer is present the door will be unlocked) or you may choose to wait in the main reception area for the trainer to welcome you. The ICT Training Room is accessed via a security code which the trainer cannot share with visitors.

The Civic building is fully accessible. The main toilet facilities are located on the first floor balcony adjacent to the Council Chambers. A kitchen is available to delegates - as indicated on the plan above – which includes microwave, fridge, boiled and fresh drinking water.
