Whilst we have worked with many Southampton schools historically, I am looking forward to working with all the schools across the city to let you know everything the NSPCC can offer regarding safeguarding children and young people.

**Speak out Stay safe** is our **free of charge** Safeguarding programme aimed at primary school-aged pupils. Further information can be found here: [www.nspcc.org.uk/speakout](http://www.nspcc.org.uk/speakout). We also offer a 6 session SEND programme to primary and secondary special schools.

We want to reach out to schools that are yet to benefit from our gentle safeguarding messages, **at no cost to the school**, so that we can confidently say that **all schools** across Southampton are working with the NSPCC to ensure that their pupils know how to **Speak out** and **Stay safe**.

**Speak out Stay safe** is currently a 'blended offer' – this means pre-recorded KS1 and KS2 assemblies along with additional, fully prepared classroom resources (to extend learning) as well as the offer of **face to face workshops with Year 5 and 6 children**. We also offer termly fundraising opportunities for schools to take part in, such as 'Number Day' and 'Childhood Day', which helps embed the Safeguarding messages even more.

The **Speak out Stay safe** programme has been designed to link directly to the curriculum, helps schools demonstrate they are meeting Safeguarding inspection requirements and supports the new mandatory Relationship Guidance.
