REPLACEMENT OF STEEL SKATE PARK WITH CONCRETE SKATE PARK

Existing Steel construction installed as part of the Heritage Lottery Funding in 2002/2003 is now showing signs of wear, requiring increasingly higher maintenance pressures. It has long been in the Central Parks Management Plan to replace it with a concrete structure. This will offer a better skating surface and crucially, better longevity with lower maintenance costs.

Now we have been able to gain access to sufficient funding to deliver this.

The Hansard Gallery has secured funding to pay for the consultation and design element, leaving more of the SCC capital for delivery of the construction, project management Planning applications and associated civil engineering.

Skatepark designer Rich Holland has developed the concept shown left.

Not shown are the rain garden soakaways around the structure to deal with water run off. This will be shown on a separate sheet.

The existing steel skatepark is shown in blue on this plan. It is 362 square meters in area.

The proposed concrete skatepark is outlined in pink. It is 840 square meters in area. A difference of 478 square meters.
