Early Language Training details:

ECaT Phases 1 & 2 (overview/refresher)

This training will cover both Phase 1 & 2 of the ECaT programme, including language rich environments, resources to support early language, and the Communication and Language audit. The session will also look at supporting early literacy.

WellComm

The WellComm programme is an early identification programme for speech and language problems and includes a screening tool and intervention ideas and activities. Sarah Steedman will be delivering an information and training session on the WellComm Early Years Toolkit, including how to apply for funding to cover the cost.

Communication development in children 0-2 years

A look at how communication skills develop in our youngest children and what we can do as professionals to nurture and respond to their emerging skills and support their families to do the same at home.

BLAST

For those new to BLAST and those requiring a refresher. The BLAST programme is a complete resource linked to the EYFS, it works on pre-linguistic skills such as attention, turn taking and listening as well as language. Attending this training will enable you to become a BLAST registered practitioner and give you the skills to deliver BLAST within your provision to small groups of children. Providers will need to purchase a BLAST pack for their setting: <u>BLAST Programme | Boosting Language, Auditory Skills and Talking</u>.

* Early Language training is free of charge, however, non-attendance or late cancellation (less than 24 hours) may incur a £10 charge.



Understanding the needs of babies and young children with SEND (Cohort 6)

Level 2 - 'Every practitioner a SEND practitioner'

Southampton Early Years Advisory Teachers are pleased to offer a sixth cohort of this exciting, accredited training opportunity for practitioners in PVI settings and childminders working with children under 5.

The aim of this training is to develop the skills, knowledge and understanding of Early Years practitioners to ensure that they are capable and confident to effectively support the children and families they work with. A range of professionals and agencies will deliver information throughout the programme, to allow practitioners to have a thorough understanding of how to support children with SEND.

Why attend?

The course will culminate in receiving a level 2 CACHE endorsed unit, alongside knowledge of SEND and best practice gained along the way.

What will it cover?

Delegates will complete module-based assessments, all of which is explained to delegates during their first day.

What does it involve?

The course will require 100% commitment from attendees with full support from their manager. The training is carried out over 3 days, 9.30 am – 4 pm at Start Point Sholing.

TRANSITION TO SCHOOL PROJECT 2025

Early Years and Childcare Providers and YR Teachers are invited to join the Early Years Advisory Teachers for the Transition to School Project 2025.

Please make every effort to attend to make sure your school/early years provision is represented, as the success of the project relies on cluster working.

Part 1 of the Transition to School Project is designed to give Early Years Practitioners and Year R teachers a good understanding of the expectations and principles from the Local Authority around transitioning children from early years provision to YR, and an opportunity to review last year's transition project. We will also be sharing Southampton's new 'All About Me' form to support children's transition.

Part 2 of the Project will involve planning the bridging project and is a chance to build relationships between local settings and schools so that transitions can be further improved for the children we work with.

The Transition to School Project will focus on:

Understanding Restrictive Practices in the Early Years Spring 2025

Due to the increase in the number of physical interventions being reported and observed, the Local Authority have looked at training options, have developed a tailored 3 hour workshop, specifically for Early Years and Childcare providers.

This training will focus on developing an understanding of:

- Statutory requirements within the EYFS around restrictive practices.
- Physical interventions and supporting delegates to be able to identify restrictive practices.
- Behaviour as a form of communication.
- Non-restrictive practices to manage behaviour and explore strategies to de-escalate behaviour.
- The use of positive language, including body language, tone, volume, to support positive behaviour.
- The effectiveness of your own setting processes and procedures when a physical intervention has occurred, including reporting and recording.
