

UNDERSTANDING RESTRICTIVE PRACTICES IN THE EARLY YEARS

Due to the increase in the number of physical interventions being reported and observed, the Local Authority have developed a tailored 3-hour workshop, specifically for Early Years and Childcare providers.

This training will focus on developing an understanding of:

- statutory requirements with in the EYFS around Restrictive practices.
- physical interventions and supporting delegates to be able to identify restrictive practices.
- behaviour as a form of communication.
- non- restrictive practices to manage behaviour and explore strategies to de-escalate behaviour.
- the use of positive language, including body language, tone, volume, to support positive behaviour.
- The effectiveness of your own setting processes and procedures when a physical intervention has occurred, including reporting and recording.

PORTAGE WORKSHOP

A Small Step Approach to Learning for Children with SEND
