Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Representation of the People Act 1983

Southampton City Council is required to carry out a review of its Polling Districts and Polling Places before 31 January 2025.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of polling districts and/or polling places currently used and invite representation and comments from interested persons.

Local political parties and councillors will be consulted and views are also invited from electors within the parliamentary constituencies of Southampton Itchen, Southampton Test, and Romsey and Southampton North, as well as such persons as may have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

The consultation period for the review will commence on the **Wednesday 4 September 2024** and end on **Wednesday 16 October 2024**.

Although the remit of the review specifically relates to polling districts and polling places, it is accepted that polling stations are inexorably linked to this review. As such comments are invited on those stations currently used and/or any suggested alternatives.
